Eligibility Requirements

- Traditions Club employee must be
 - In good standing with Supervisor
 - Employed for at least one consecutive year
 - Averages at least 15 hours worked at Traditions Club per week
- T.C. Bryan Scholarship Program is not available to employees whose anticipated employment period is less than six months.
- Application must be made by a current employee.

How much can you request?

- \$2,500 Scholarship
- This scholarship does not automatically renew, though students may reapply each semester they meet the eligibility requirements.

Information

Conditions

- Must have a minimum, cumulative GPA of 2.0, providing updated scores at the end of the semester, at Texas A&M University, Blinn College or technical school.
 - Applicants must be admitted students of the selected institution and must have met all standard academic requirements for the courses taken.
 - In good standing with the institution
 - Enrolled as a full-time student according to the institution standards.
 - Some exceptions apply, if a senior has a set number of hours remaining to complete their degree in their final semester the student will qualify.
- Scholarship money must be used on tuition and fees, books, room and board and will be paid directly to the institution.

Application Deadlines

Fall – June 1st

Summer – February 1st

Spring – November 1st

Applications postmarked or delivered after the above dates will not be considered. No incomplete applications will be considered.

Letters of Recommendation

Character references in the form of a letter of recommendation from a supervisor or academic professor.

Personal Interview

Applicant must agree to a personal interview if offered.

*All aspects of the T.C. Bryan Scholarship are subject to board approval and can be changed at any time.

There is no guaranteed issuance.

- Scholarships are limited.
